Current

- Of the month, or even of the day!
- Detailed
 - Identify from 20 cm, interpret from 1 m
- Accurate
 - Comparable to terrestrial methods, the aerial image as extension
- Limited impact
 - Noise & pollution, unhampered exploitation, air traffic
- Affordable
 - The cost shouldn't be an obstacle; become a motivation

Learnings & conclusion

- What was experimental 4 years ago is now an established, alternative and validated technology
- Technical aspects are gradually all solved, with room for punctual improvements
- The supply meets the demand and generates new ones
- A normalisation is needed (standards, rules, rights & duties)
